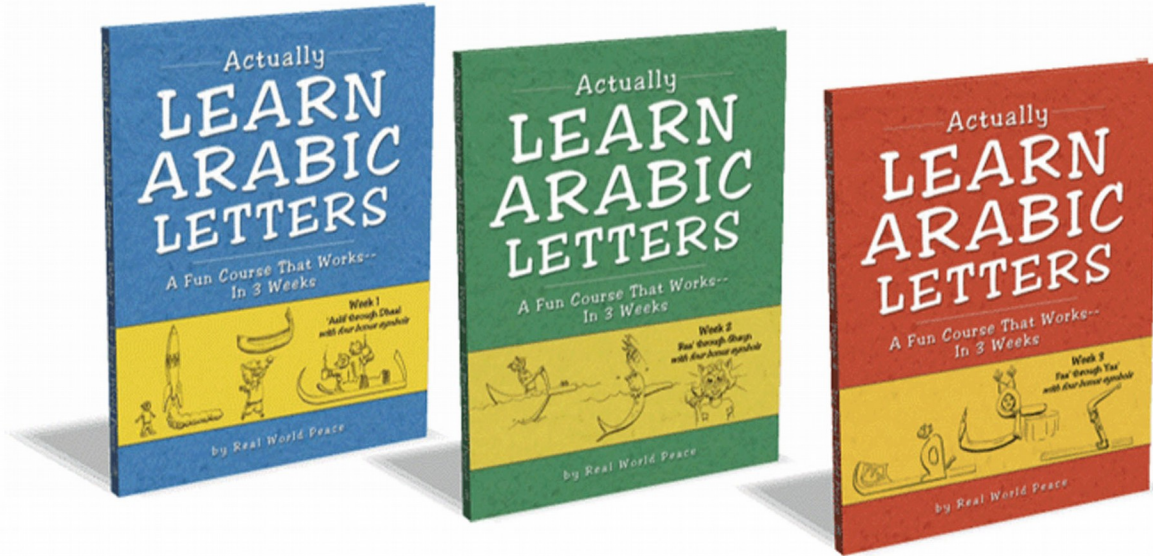






Market research indicated that Arabic was perceived as a language that was alien, threatening, incomprehensible, and impossible to learn.

*Actually Learn Arabic Letters* was a stealth peace project to promote intelligence, tolerance, and mutual respect, targeted initially for a needy audience of 120,000 servicemen in Iraq. Its mission then was to be easy, familiar, non-threatening, comprehensible, and simple. Even for ordinary people and children.

This was achieved by adopting a "Dr. Seuss" style for the workbooks--creating crazy, memorable, fun pictures and poems for each letter, to make learning enjoyable and effective.

Tested at UCLA and USC. It actually works! The sheep is singing the "Barbara Ann" song from the Beach Boys.
